Email, postcard or 3-4 sentences of information	Write a few short sentences with support- using expressions which they have already learned. Eg simple notes or messages.  Write a short text (3-4 sentences) on a familiar topic, adapting language they have already learnt.
6	Understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources.	Speak with increasing fluency, confidence and spontaneity.  Continue to improve accuracy with correct pronunciation and intonation.  Give short prepared talk on topic of own choice	Understand the main points and opinions in written texts in various contexts eg postcard from a pen pal.  Discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in French.	Write a varying length for differing purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures they have learned. (Paragraphs of 3 or 4 sentences)
