

Draw your own dragon and describe what each part of his body is doing using verbs ending in 'ing'. For example, 'He is breathing fire', 'He is swishing his long tail.'

Go on a shape hunt in your local area. Can you describe the shapes you find? Eg how many sides? corners? curved or straight? equals sides?

Discuss: Spring is the best season of the year - discuss reasons for and against. You could also look for signs of Spring.

Write an adventure story about a dragon.

Make a dragon collage or model using things that you would normally recycle.
