Research the life of either William Wilberforce or Elizabeth Fry and create a fact-file explaining how they fought for justice.

Find out about the money used in Victorian times and design a poster showing the different coin values.

Write a diary entry for a GWR apprentice in Victorian Swindon.

Create an advert for our year 4 play.

Create a lift the flap game for at least 8 different homophones.

Create a model of a Victorian house. You can make this on a computer / iPad or a 3D model.
