Design a Roman numerals poster.

Research the origin of the names of your family members.

Create a Roman mosaic picture out of paper.

Write a menu for a Roman feast with traditional dishes.

Go on a 'sound walk', jot down all the different sounds you hear and identify whether they are man-made or natural sounds.

Write some Roman numeral mental maths problems for a friend to solve.

Research and explain a Hypocaust (Roman central heating system).

Keep a food diary for a week and highlight all the foods you think are healthy.

Create a game to revise any of our year 4 spelling rules. For example ous endings, y to ied, tion/sion endings, etc.

Measure the height of everyone in your family and draw the results pictorially in proportion.

Design a job advert for a Roman job (not in the army)
Eg. Patrician, plebeian, charioteer, smith, merchant, sea-captain, scholar, gladiator or slave.

Create Celtic jewellery out of foil.
