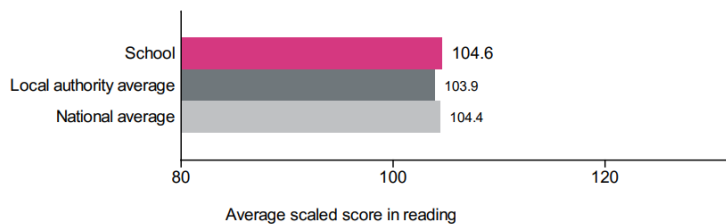

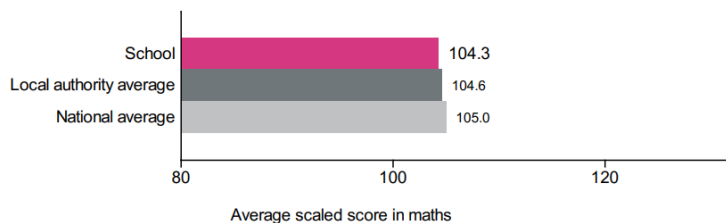
### Reading
