- Write a sentence, or draw a picture and label it, about a plant growing in your home, garden or local area.

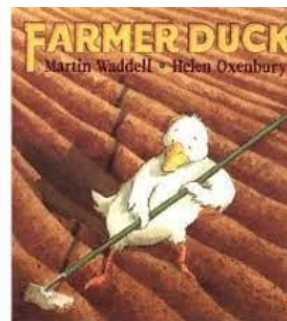
Understanding the World

Mathematics

- Using some of your toys at home, create some number bonds to numbers within 10. E.g. 4 red cars and 3 blue cars make 7 cars altogether.
