


# Year 4, Term 4

### The Anglo-Saxons



Please remember to do the following activities daily:

Reading    Spelling    Times tables

Then **complete 1** of these activities each week. You should spend **no longer than 45 minutes per week** on an activity. All children **MUST** complete the spelling homework, reading comprehension task and Growth Mindset activity over the half term.

#### Maths:

Practise your times tables on **TTRS** regularly. Aim to go on 5 times a week, in the same way you practise your reading. See if you can make your way up the effort league table.

#### Time

#### History:
